Directions to Remington United Methodist Church:

From Warrenton, VA: Take Rt 29/15 south; proceed past Rt 17 & Rt. 28; turn left onto James Madison Rd. Turn right at Remington Post Office on left, onto Bowen St. Proceed approx 2 blocks to church (on right). Parking is located on both sides of building & across the street.

From Culpeper, VA: Take Rt. 29/15 north; proceed until one street before Rt. 28. Turn right onto James Madison Rd into Remington. Turn left at Remington Post Office (situated on right); proceed approximately 2 blocks to church on right. Parking is located on both sides of the building and in the lot across the street from the church.

Saturday Night Alive!

Folks at RUMC believe our children come first! They are always encouraged to attend worship services and functions in our family-friendly church. For those under age 5, we offer nursery care during the 11 a.m. worship service. Our nursery is staffed by loving, experienced volunteers from within our church family. Two rooms are available; one for infants and one for toddlers and preschoolers. The nursery is located in the lower level of the education wing. Kids ages 5 and up are invited after the Children's Message in the 11 a.m. service to participate in kids-only worship designed specifically for them. We have interactive learning opportunities, fun activities, and inspirational songs that children love to sing!
